Capital letters are the uppercase version of letters.

Capital letters can show when a sentence is starting, if a word is important or if a word is a proper noun.

Read these sentences.

A jack can lift up cars.

- Is this sentence talking about a tool, or about men called Jack?
- How do you know?

I love Turkey.

- Is this sentence talking about the country or the bird?
