Capital letters are the uppercase version of letters.

Capital letters can show when a sentence is starting, if a word is important or if a word is a proper noun.

neptune

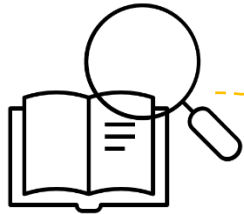
emily
